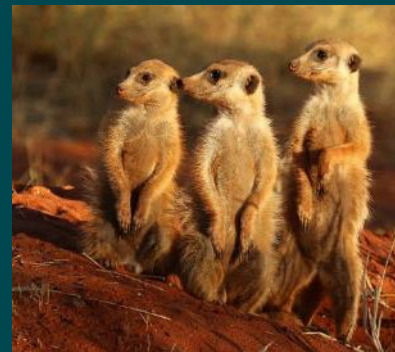

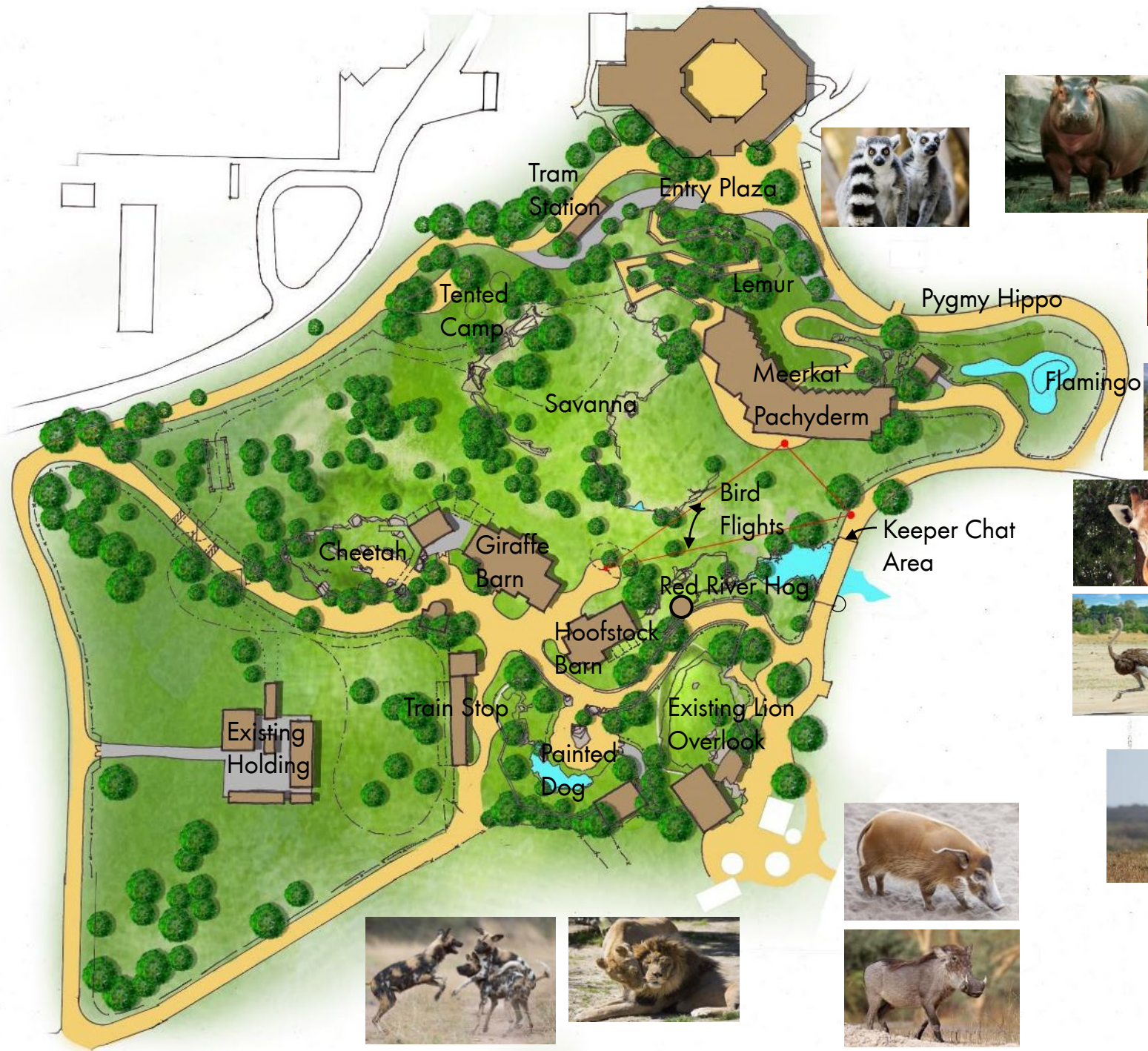


# Schematic Design

# Schematic Plan



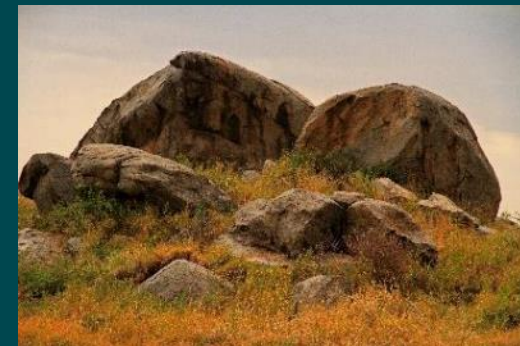
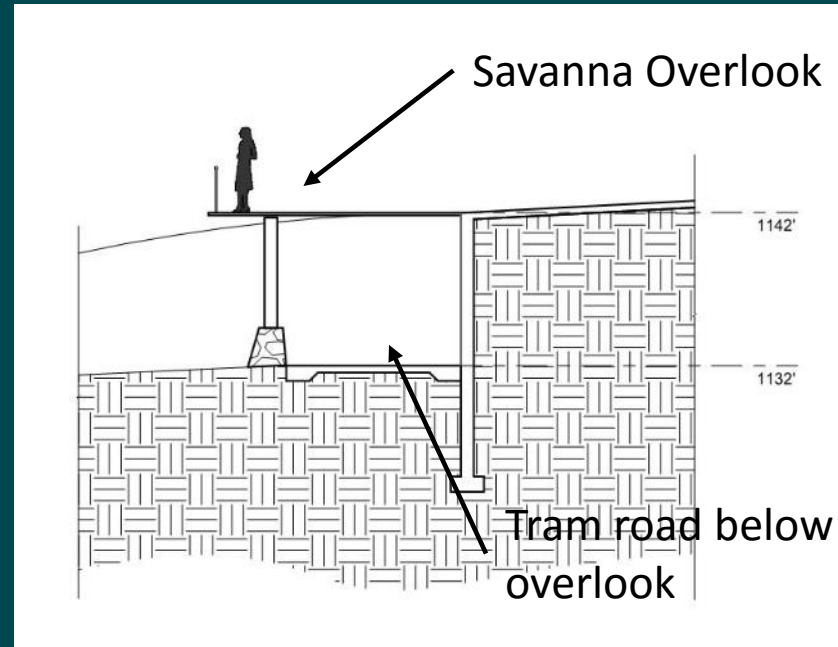
# Schematic Plan - Building Numbers

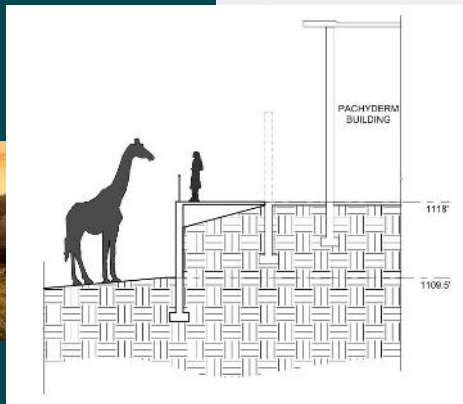
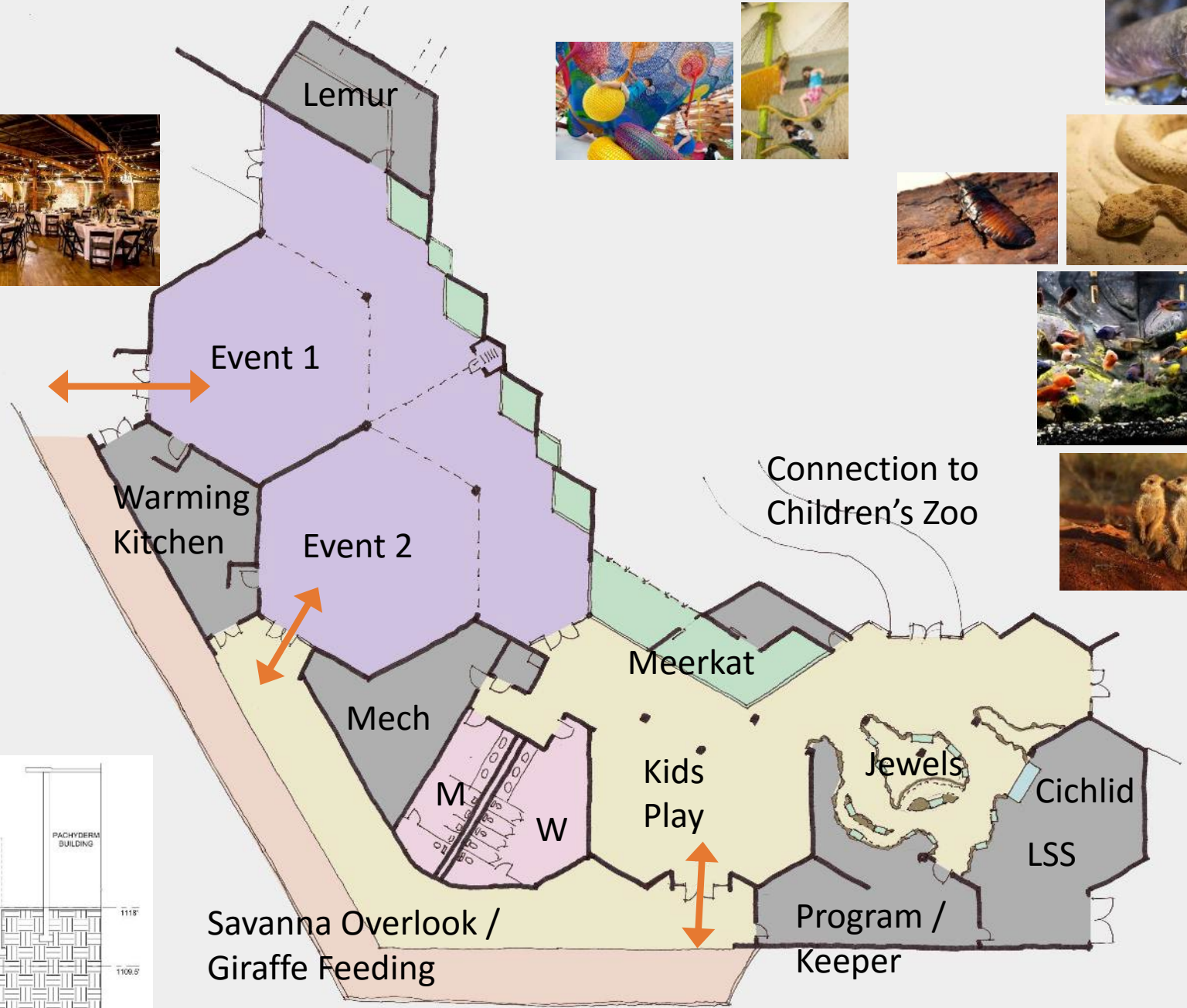


Lemur Holding



# Pachyderm

- Event spaces to west
- Exhibits / kids play to east
- Connection to Children's Zoo via ramp
- Expanded south deck allows for giraffe interactions



# Pygmy Hippo / Flamingo

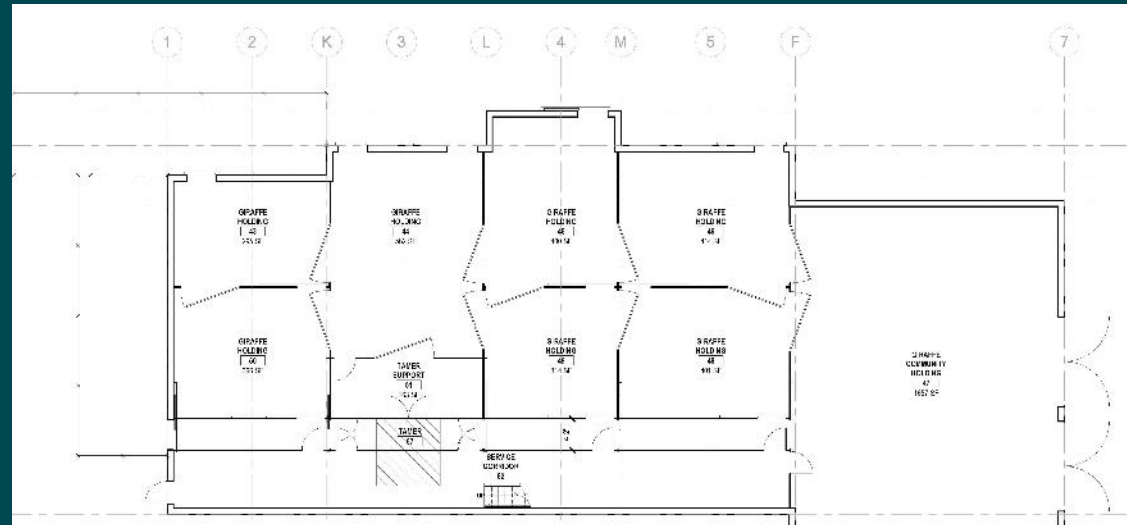
- Pygmy hippo and flamingo share an exhibit
- Water depth to vary for each species
- Area for flamingo interaction along guest path
- Water to be part of the wetlands system



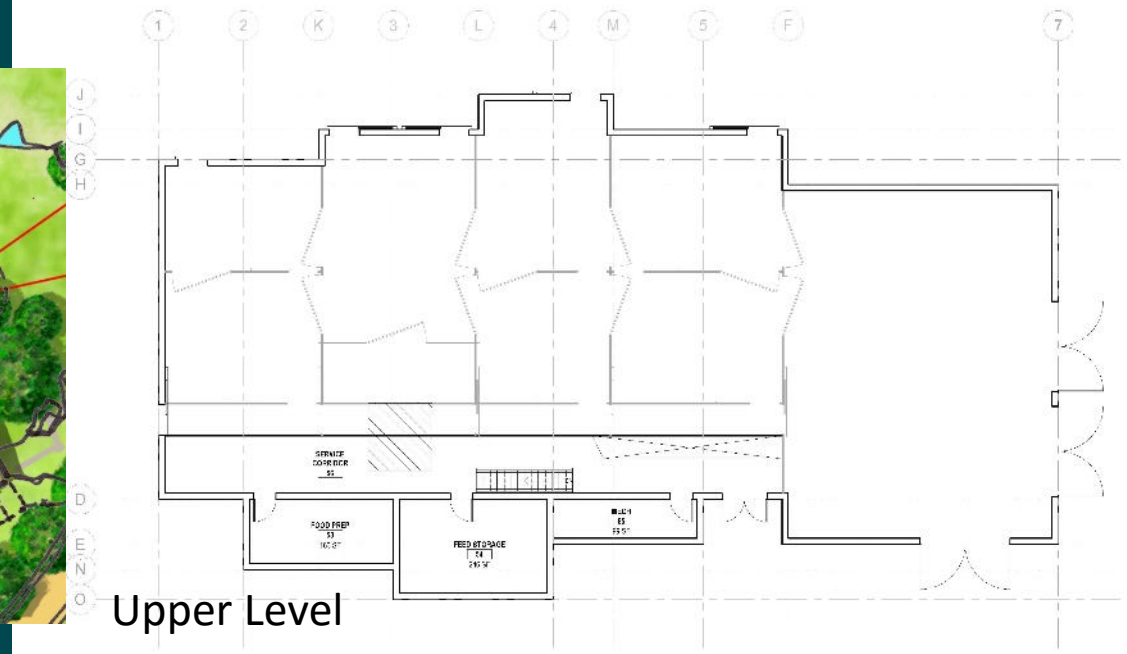


# Savanna / Giraffe Barn

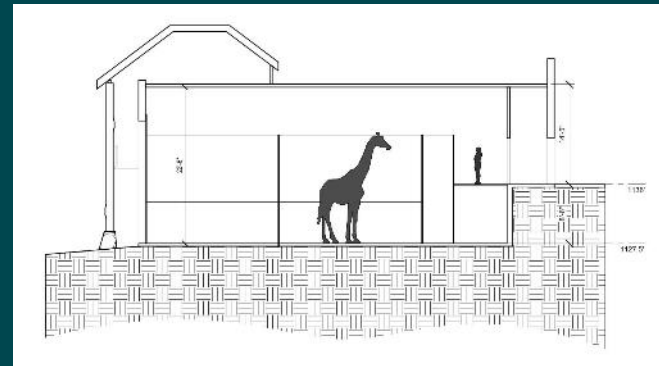
- One and a half story building; guests / feeding at upper level and giraffe stalls on lower level



Lower Level

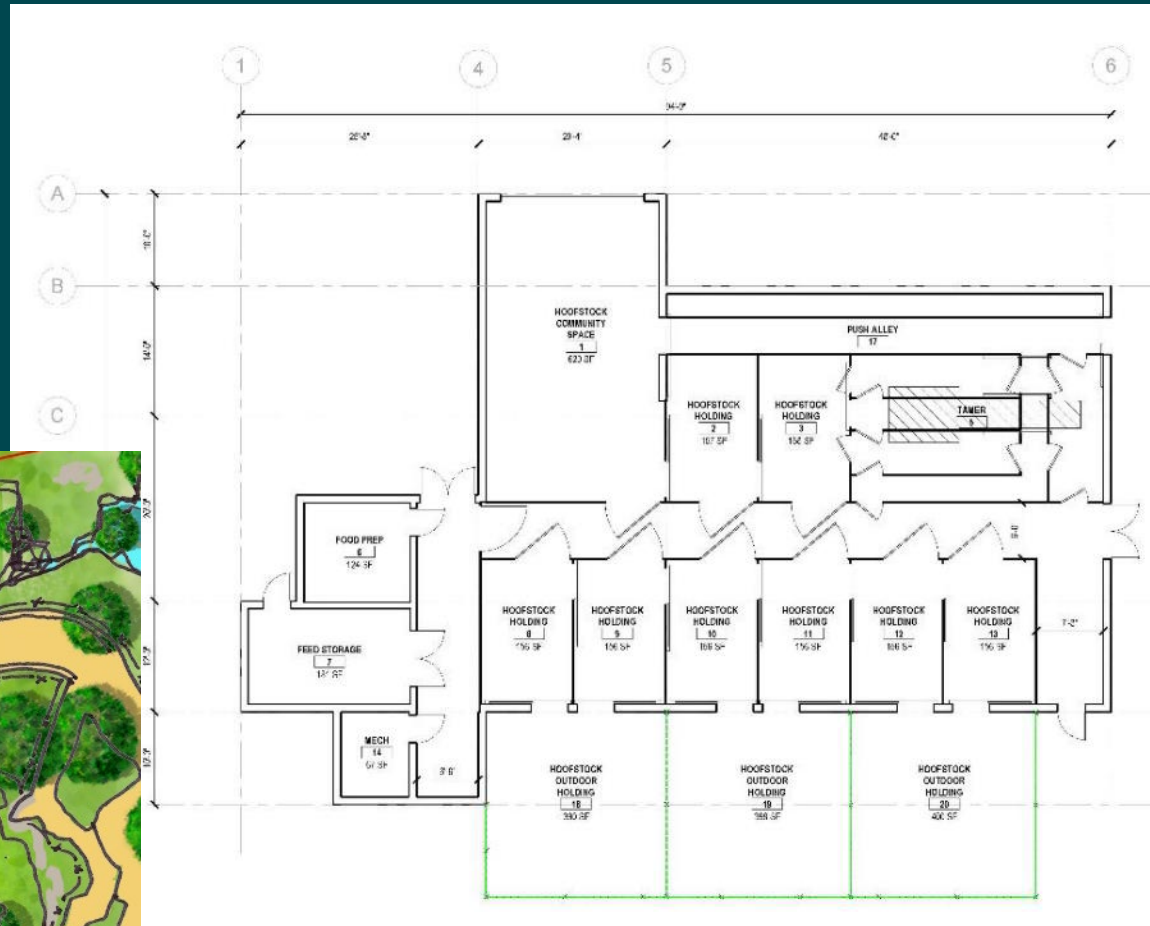


Upper Level



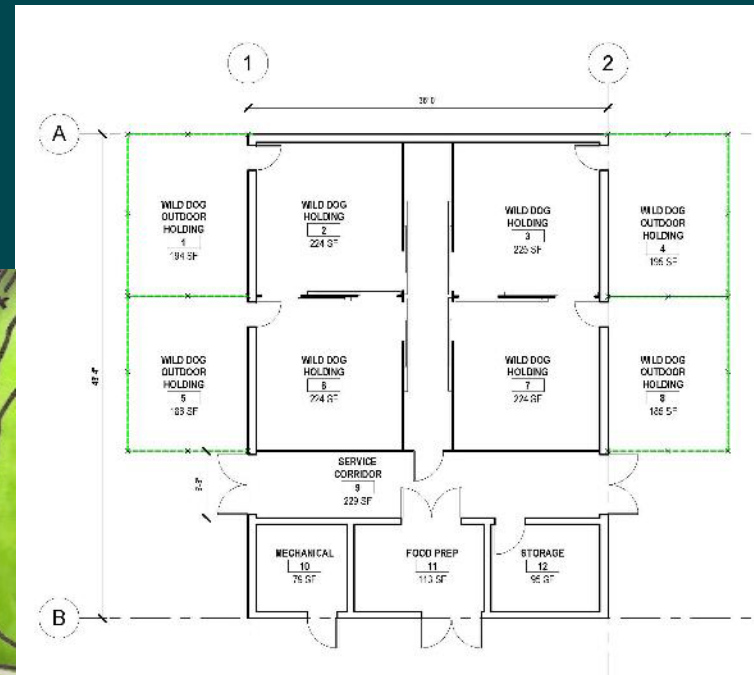
# Savanna / Hoofstock Barn

- Central plaza between giraffe and hoofstock allows guests a peek at the animals in their holding



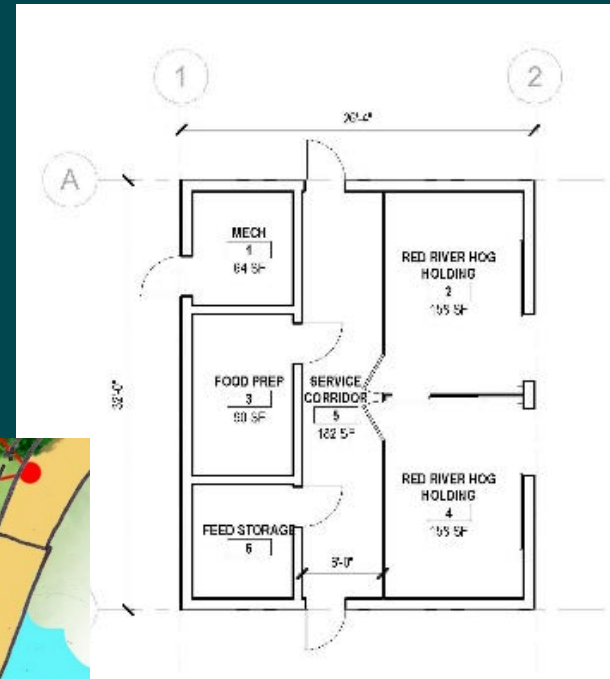
# Painted Dog

- Pool to be part of the wetlands system
- Viewing from plaza



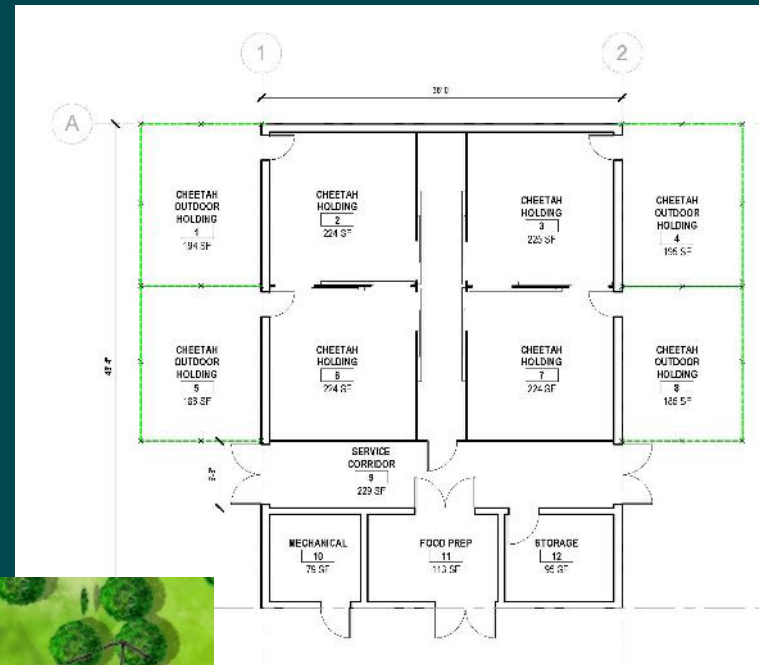
# Red River Hog / Warthog

- Watering hole is outside their habitat
- May be able to attach holding to hoofstock but is currently separate
- Perhaps shaped like a rondavel



# Cheetah

- Habitat has upper level guest viewing
- The cheetahs can utilize the whole exhibit below and have a circular run path
- Kopjes allow the cheetahs to be elevated and view the savanna



# Train Ride

- The train can go into the savanna and the existing hoofstock area
- Crossing achieved by constructing a bridge across the existing lower grade



# Existing Holding

- Okapi stay in their existing holding building
- Secretary bird / guinea fowl go into existing holding
- Dik Dik go into existing holding

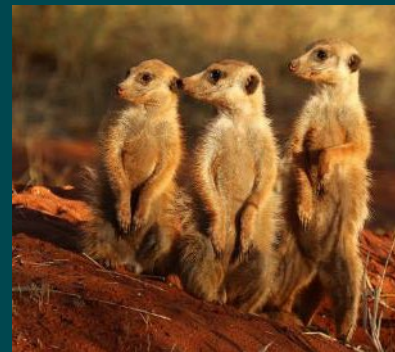


# Next Steps
